Three Jimmy Page Style Rock Licks



Jimmy Page is best known as the lead guitarist for the legendary rock group Led Zeppelin. One of the most emulated classic rock guitarists of all time, Page wrote many of the greatest songs produced by the band, including 'Stairway to Heaven' and 'Whole Lotta Love'. The three sample lines below are designed to demonstrate a little of his approach to Classic Rock soloing.

These lines are taken from a book published by the Fundamental Changes music publishers and now available on Amazon. '**100 Classic Rock Licks for Guitar**' also includes many 'in the style of' lines by other legendary Classic Rock guitarists, ranging from Ritchie Blackmore through to Angus Young of AC/DC.
